2019-2021 NATIONAL ACTION PLAN OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA ON THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 1325 ON WOMEN, PEACE AND SECURITY AND TIMETABLE FOR ITS IMPLEMENTATION

INTRODUCTION

Since 2000, the international community has been gradually strengthening the approach that equal involvement of women is necessary for comprehensive and all-encompassing peace and security. Based on this approach, on 31 October 2000, the United Nations (UN) Security Council (SC) adopted Resolution 1325 entitled "Women, Peace and Security". The Resolution is the first such document adopted by the UN which refers, in institutional terms, to the impact of armed conflicts on women, involvement of women in conflict prevention, conflict resolution and peacebuilding. The Resolution refers to the important role that women play in conflict prevention and resolution, negotiations on peaceful resolution, peacekeeping, peacebuilding, other humanitarian missions, as well as post-conflict reconstruction.

The Resolution 1325 is based on the following five pillars: prevention, protection, participation, relief and recovery and monitoring.

Since protection and promotion of human rights and fundamental freedoms are among the priorities of the Armenian internal and foreign policy, the increase of the role of women in the public life, as well as their involvement in peace and security are of utmost significance for the Republic of Armenia.

In the context of the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict, Armenia attaches special importance to ensuring the active participation of women in all stages of conflict cycle and protection of women affected by the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict and their human rights and fundamental freedoms.

Thus, Armenia considers the Action Plan on implementation of the provisions of the UN SC Resolution 1325 as a national mechanism for the protection and promotion of women's rights in public life.

By the decision of the Government No 483-N of 4 May 2017 and of the Prime Minister of the Republic of Armenia No 1014-A of 13 September 2017 an Action Plan for 2017-2019, Committed to National Human Rights Protection Strategy has been adopted since its point 76 thereof directly refers to the development of a National Action Plan on the implementation of the provisions of the Resolution 1325 as well as an Interagency Commission has been established for the same purpose.

Accordingly, the Interagency Commission is composed of the representatives of:

- 1) the Prime Minister's Office:
- 2) the Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
- 3) the Ministry of Defence;
- 4) the Ministry of Justice;
- 5) the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs;
- 6) the Ministry of Economic Development and Investments;
- 7) the Ministry of Emergency Situations;
- 8) the Ministry of Territorial Administration and Development;

- 9) the Police of the Republic of Armenia;
- 10) the National Institute of Education of the Ministry of Education and Science;
- 11) the State Migration Service of the Ministry of Territorial Administration and Development;
- 12) the Armenian Red Cross Society.

The coordination of the development of the National Plan has been carried out by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Report on the implementation of the Resolution 1325 by the Republic of Armenia has been circulated as an UN official document (S/2017/54) on 19 January 2017.
